Assignment Title: Technical assessment, architectonic design, specifications, estimated cost and supervision of civil works, Installation of medical devises and Furniture's plot of existing pediatric hospital building.

The Government of Albania has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Health System Improvement Project (HSIP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services ("the Services") include "***Technical assessment, architectonic design, specifications, estimated cost and supervision of civil works, Installation of medical devises and Furniture's plot of existing pediatric hospital building***"

Overall objective of the assignment is Upgrading and refurbishment works of Pediatric hospital (within the University Hospital Center of Tirana) infrastructure based on a strategic plan prepared by the hospital management authorities, and aligned with the overall Hospital Master Plan (April 14, 2014). The existing structures will be subject to refurbishment that will allow modernization and improvement of service delivery.

Specific objectives of this assignment are to provide the following activities:

- 1- Technical assessment of the existing pediatric building,
- 2- Engineering Design Project Studies, Technical Specification and Bill of Quantity
- 3- Preparation of technical specification medical device and Furniture's plot Installation of existing pediatric hospital building

Supervision of Civil Works for physical rehabilitation and upgrading of Pediatric hospital infrastructure based on a strategic plan prepared by the hospital management authorities, and aligned with the overall Hospital Master Plan, version 2014.

The Ministry of Health, through Project Coordination Unit (PCU) now invites eligible international consultants ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. Consultants may

associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

The short listing criteria are:

3.	Assignment-relevant experience and qualification of key personnel	30 points

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's [Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers](#) (January 2011, revised July 2014), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

The consultant should be an international firm. The selection method to be applied is Consultants Qualification Selection (CQS), in accordance with the procedures set out the World Bank's *Guidelines Selection and Employment of Consultants Under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers*" (January 2011, revised July 2014).

This assignment should be performed within 10 months period, divided respectively

(a) 3 (three) months for Phase 1 & Phase 2,

(b) 6 (six) months for the supervision phase and

(c) 1 (one) month after completion of the completion of works liability period (12 months after the civil works completion date).

The consultant is expected to start the service on June 2016 and to complete it by June 2018. Between Phases 1 and 2 will be a waiting period of three months to allow for procurement of the related civil works. The contract will be lump-sum basis.
